Wednesday 21st January **‘Kimpton in the 21st Century’**

Juliet will present ‘visual memories’ of Kimpton Village during the first 25 years of this century.

Wednesday 18th March **‘Kimpton AFS, 1939-1946’**

John Pollington will talk about the Kimpton Auxiliary Fire Service, one of the many volunteer village fire brigades that assisted the National Fire Service during the 2nd World War.

Wednesday 15th April **‘Sons of St Albans’**

Terry Turner will talk about a variety of men whose lives have touched St Albans in some way, from Francis Bacon to Stephen Hawking, taking in Nicholas Breakspear, Samuel Ryder and Lord Grimsthorpe along the way.

Wednesday 17th June **Rothamsted Manor**

We will make a guided tour of 17th Century Rothamsted Manor, where, in 1843, Sir John Lawes established the Rothamsted Experimental Station. The details of the tour are yet to be confirmed but it will probably take place during the afternoon.

Wednesday 15th July **Letchworth Garden City walking tour**

Liz Eastwood will be our guide in Letchworth, introducing us to the history of the First Garden City, inspired by the visionary Ebenezer Howard.
